**Greta Sokoloff, Ph.D.**, Research Scientist, Department of Psychology, University of Iowa, Iowa City, IA. The title of her talk will be "Sleep and sleep-related behavior as early predictors of typical and atypical brain development".

**Jared M. Saletin, Ph.D.**, Associate Professor, Department of Psychiatry and Human Behavior, Brown University, and the Associate Director of E.P. Bradley Hospital Sleep Research Laboratory, Providence RI. The title of his talk will be "Sleep, Cognition and the Developing Brain".
